Traveler Responsibility C@DE

As of March 5, 2021, all travelers visiting or residents returning to Pitkin County are required to fill out a form on the county website acknowledging local COVID-19 policies and are encouraged, although not required per CDC travel guidance, to get tested before arrival.

How is the Traveler Responsibility Code different from the Traveler Affidavit?

The biggest difference is the new program asks individuals to follow CDC's travel recommendations in lieu of pre-arrival testing requirements.

The new Traveler Responsibility Code also has individuals acknowledge national and local guidance that includes:

- 1. Current public health orders including wearing a mask in public
- 2. Limit personal gatherings to no more than 10 individuals from 2 households
- 3. If exposed to COVID-19, quarantine even if it prolongs your stay
- 4. Self-isolate and get tested if experiencing symptoms
- 5. Wash hands often
- 6. Social distance
- 7. Follow CDC travel guidance

Pitkin County has made progress to slow the spread of COVID-19 and keep our businesses and ski areas open. Our entire community, our residents and our guests have a responsibility to help us keep transmission levels as low as possible and our community open.
